**"Rumours of Another World"** . . . What on earth are we missing? by Philip Yancey. In this book Philip Yancey asks "Is the visible world around us all there is?" and "What rumours of another world might it convey?"

**"Shadowmancer"** by G P Taylor. A sorcerer seeks to control the highest power in the Universe.... The only people in his way are three young people and the dapper, sharp-shooting Jacob Crane. Set in the 18th century, it is packed full of history, folklore and smuggling. This tale of their epic battle will grip both young and old.
