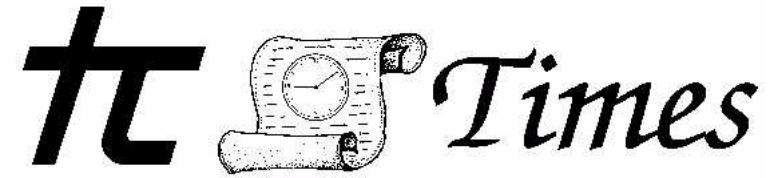

### TC Breakaway 2005

8-10 April 2005

Letton Hall in Norfolk has been booked for our Breakaway weekend. It is a handsome 18<sup>th</sup> century house and has been in private hands as a family home for most of its life, but is now run by a group of Christians who wish it to be a house for the Lord. It is available for groups like ours to 'get away from it all' and spend a short while together.

The house stands in its own grounds of about 10 acres with plenty of space for outdoor activities. Indoors, there is a games area in the basement, two large sitting rooms, a dining room and a kitchen on the ground floor, and bedrooms on the first and second floors which accommodate 70 people in a variety of rooms. There is also a converted stable block, known as Dolphin Court, which provides a further 50 sleeping places and some additional facilities. As before, we have booked both the Hall and the Court, so this should give us plenty of scope to accommodate our numbers and add variety to the weekend.

The weekend starts at 7:30pm on Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> April and finishes at 3:15pm on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> April.

This year we have invited Bob Hunt of All Nations Christian College to be our guest speaker. Bob is a long-standing friend of Therfield Chapel and will be sensitive to our needs. He is an experienced and engaging speaker and will bring his love and passion for people with him. He and his wife Diane will make a welcome contribution to all aspects of the weekend.

It is our intention that everyone should have an enjoyable time. There will be teaching sessions of course, but also games, indoors and outside, and the opportunity to get away from the house for a while if you wish. We promise you, you won't be bored.
